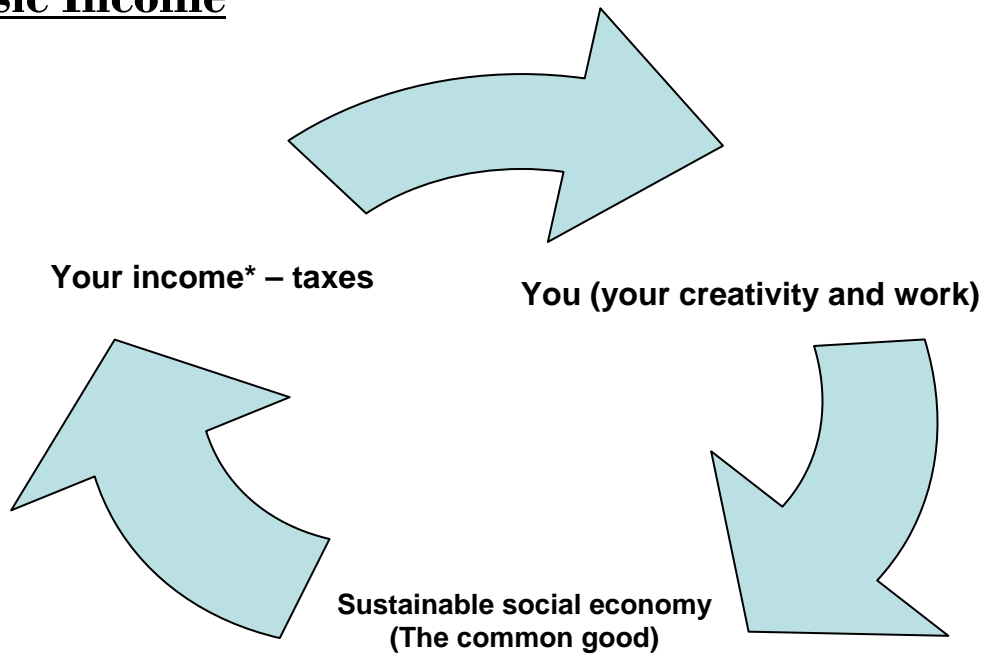


Presentation of the functionality of the basic income for a sustainable social economy

Basic Income



$$* \text{ Income} = (\text{BI} + ((\text{OI} - \text{BI}) * \text{PPT}))$$

BI = Basic Income

OI = Own Income

PPT = Percentage Progressive Tax

$$\text{Example: } \underline{1.290,00} \text{ €} = (\underline{800,00} \text{ €} + ((1.500,00 - 800,00 \text{ €}) * 30\%))¹$$

$$1(1.500,00 \text{ €} - 800,00 \text{ €}) = 700,00 \text{ €}$$

$$(700,00 \text{ €} * 30\%) = 210,00 \text{ €}$$

$$700,00 \text{ €} - 210,00 \text{ €} = \underline{490,00} \text{ €}$$

A percentage progressive tax in three steps is possible and looks like this:

1. Step = 0% until a gross income of 800,00 €
2. Step = 30% as from 801,00 € till 3.000,00 €
3. Step = 45% as from 3.001,00 €

Remarks concerning the finance of the basic income

All kind of incomes are submitted to taxes. It means income as well as return on investment, rent income etc. are taxed following the percentage progressive tax system.

With this tax system, real as well as abusive taxes get obsolete like for example the real estate tax and the dog tax and other hidden taxes.

The taxes on income are including the health insurance contribution. The contribution and cost for the unemployment and pension insurance get obsolete while being financed with the basic income for all from the cradle to the bier.

A low value added tax (7%) is due on sustainable and ecological products. On luxury and goods that are detrimental for the environment the value added (21%) tax increases threefold¹.

Furthermore all subsidies are scraped for the private economy, which support the manufacturing of products detrimental for the environment.
